Junior membership age requirements & playing privilege times:

- A junior member must be under 19 prior to September 30, 2010 and older than 12 as of May 1, 2010. A junior is not permitted to tee off between 3:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. on weekdays except during the school year when juniors are allowed to tee off between 3:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Mondays and Fridays only.
- A junior is not permitted to tee off before 10 a.m. Monday through Friday and 11:30 a.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.
- A junior may book tee times up to 3 days in advance.
- Some 18 year olds may not be eligible for MGA/MLGA events.
