MEMBERSHIP TYPE	Play Opportunities and Booking Privileges
<b>OAK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o No playing restrictions-may play at any time of any day</li> <li>o May book tee times up to 7 days in advance</li> <li>o May have a set tee time allocated for Saturday, Sunday and Holiday mornings</li> </ul>
<b>ASPEN</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o No playing restrictions on Mondays through Fridays.</li> <li>o May not tee off prior to 11:30 a.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays</li> <li>o May book tee times up to 5 days in advance</li> </ul>
<b>YOUNG OAK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Must be less than 31 years of age as of January 1, 2009</li> <li>o No playing restrictions-may play at any time of any day</li> <li>o May book tee times up to 7 days in advance</li> </ul>
<b>YOUNG ASPEN</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Must be less than 31 years of age as of January 1, 2009</li> <li>o No playing restrictions Mondays through Fridays</li> <li>o May not tee off prior to 11:30 a.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays</li> <li>o May book tee times up to 5 days in advance</li> </ul>
<b>JUNIOR</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Must be under 19 years of age prior to September 30, 2009 and older than 12 as of May 1, 2009</li> <li>o Not allowed to tee off between 3:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. on weekdays except during the school year when tee offs between 3:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Mondays and Fridays is allowed</li> <li>o Not allowed to tee off before 10 a.m. Monday through Friday and 11:30 a.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays</li> <li>o May book tee times up to 4 days in advance</li> <li>o (Some 18 year olds may not be eligible for MGA/MLGA events)</li> </ul>
<b>CORPORATE</b>	<p>Option I</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Qualified companies register up to five (5) employees to share two gold cards that entitle any two of the registered employees to play a max of 18 holes of golf once a day</li> <li>o Five registered employees have same play and booking privileges as Oak members</li> </ul>
	<p>Option II</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Qualified companies register one (1) employee in the "Oak" category and receive 50 Corporate Golf Passes</li> <li>o Oak member has full Oak membership play and booking privileges</li> <li>o Golf pass holders may book 5 days in advance, may not book a tee time prior to 11:30 am on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays</li> </ul>
	<p>Option III</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o 100 Corporate Green Passes (100 games/season)</li> <li>o Pass holders may book 7 days in advance</li> <li>o Pass holders may not book a tee time prior to 11:30 am on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays</li> </ul>

<b>FAMILY MEMBERSHIP</b>	<p><u>A. Dual Golfer Family</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o If two parents are active golfing shareholders (Oak and/or Aspen members), then an unlimited number of their children (under the age of 19) may golf at no additional charge</li> <li>o Option not available to Corporate Members</li> <li>o Family still gets the spousal discount of \$250.00</li> <li>o Represents a savings of \$250 plus \$456 for each junior</li> <li>o Normal restrictions on <b>Junior</b> tee times and booking privileges apply to children in this membership category</li> </ul> <hr/> <p><u>B. Single Parent is Active Golfing Member:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o If one parent is an active golfing shareholder (Oak or Aspen), then discounted golf dues are available for their children (under the age of 19) as follows;</li> <li>o \$265 for 1st <b>Junior</b>, \$159 for 2nd <b>Junior</b> (prices inclusive of GST), and no additional charge for any further <b>Juniors</b> (see definition of <b>Junior</b> above)</li> <li>o Represents a savings of \$190 for the first <b>Junior</b> member, \$297 for the second and \$456 for each <b>Junior</b> thereafter</li> <li>o Option not available to Corporate Members</li> <li>o Normal restrictions on <b>Junior</b> tee times and booking privileges apply to children in this membership category</li> </ul> <hr/> <p><u>C. Families with Young Adult(s) Aged 19-24:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Available to families who have at least one active golfing Oak or Aspen parent shareholder</li> <li>o Allows for up to 3 young adults aged 19-24 to golf for \$615/year each (including GST and CARF)</li> <li>o Represents a savings of \$574 per young adult to a max of three.</li> <li>o To qualify for this rate, the young adult must be living at home and be enrolled full or part-time in school.</li> <li>o Option not available to Corporate Members</li> <li>o <b>Young Aspen</b> category play restrictions and booking privileges apply</li> </ul>
<b>NIGHT LEAGUE LADY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Monday League players may only tee off on Mondays between 5:00 – 6:30 p.m.</li> <li>o Wednesday League players may only tee off on Wednesdays between 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.</li> <li>o Both Monday and Wednesday league players restricted to 9 holes of golf</li> <li>o Both Monday and Wednesday league player may book tee times 3 days in advance</li> </ul>
<b>GROUP ASSOCIATE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o A non-shareholder category</li> <li>o Available to groups of between 3 and 5 players</li> <li>o Same play restrictions and booking privileges as Aspen category</li> </ul>

<sup>2</sup> Otherwise known as "CARF". Monies go directly to a separate account to be used for major capital assets and course renovations.

Annual golf dues for Oak, Aspen, Young Oak, and Corporate memberships include club storage and cleaning, locker, and annual Manitoba Golf Association fees.

There is an annual *share maintenance fee* of \$125.00, including GST. This is billed each November and payment is due by December 31<sup>st</sup>. This fee serves to keep your share in good standing. A member may take a leave of absence from golf in any year and maintain their shareholder status by ensuring the *share maintenance fee* is paid annually.
